## My Cousin Tremaine

The Henderson Grove Youth Mission went to visit my cousin Tremaine Hackney during the summer and again at Christmas. Tremaine is a 19 year-old quadriplegic, which means he's paralyzed from the neck down. He was in a car accident several years ago.

When we arrived at his house, he had a big smile on his face. The first time we visited him, we asked him what was his favorite scripture, and he responded that he didn't know. We read scriptures, said prayers, sang a few songs, and then shared a book with him entitled "How to Become a Christian."

There were 10 steps in the book, and these are:

- RECOGNIZE that you are NOT a Christian because you are GOOD, for God's Word declares "There is NONE that doeth good, no not one". Rom 3·12
- 2. **RECOGNIZE** that you are NOT a Christian because you are doing the BEST you can, for God's Word declares, "All have sinned, and come short of the glory of God". Rom 3:23
- 3. **RECOGNIZE** that you are NOT necessarily a Christian because you are a member of some church, for again God's word declares "that many have a FORM of godliness, but deny the power thereof: from such turn away". 2 Tim 3:5
- CONFESS that you are a GUILTY sinner in God's sight, for you have broken HIS commandments, and ALL the world has become guilty before HIM Rom3:19
- 5. **CONFESS** that you CANNOT save yourself, "for by grace are e saved through faith; and that not of yourselves; it is the GIFT of God". Eph 2:8
- 6. **CONFESS** that you are hopelessly lost and under condemnation WITHOUT Jesus Christ as your personal savior. Luke 19:10
- 7. **BELIEVE** that Good News that Christ died for the UNGODLY. Rom 5:8 He therefore died for you and settled your sin debt on Calvary's cross.
- 8. **BELIEVE** the glorious news that Christ raised from the dead by the power of GOD is now able to save ALLL who come unto God by Him. Heb 7:25
- 9. **CALL** on the name of the Lord Jesus, with a SINCERE desire to be saved from your sins, for God has promised that "whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved" Rom 10:13
- 10. **RELY** on God's sure promise NOT upon your feelings and by FAITH declare that you are saved by the blood of Jesus Christ, shed for the forgiveness of your sins and openly confess HIM with your mouth as your Lord and Savior.

Tremaine really enjoyed our visits. He had a nice time fellowshipping with us, and he is very thankful for our visits. Please join me in praying for my cousin Tremaine.
