WHO:

BELIEF:

PURPOSE:

"The purpose of the Woman's Baptist Home and Foreign Missionary Convention shall be to:

- organize and to improve participation in Missionary Circles inclusive of Seniors, Young Adults, and Youth in Baptist churches of the State;
- promote a broader spirit of missionary endeavor;
- encourage the study of the Bible and other missionary books;
- support the major objectives: State and Foreign Missions, Shaw University and Shaw Divinity School, J. J. Johnson Baptist Assembly, and Central Children's Home of North Carolina;
- cooperate with GBSC."

THIS ORGANIZATION:

The One-Day District Conference of
WBH&FMC.

ITS PURPOSE:

Convenes to:

- Review missionary progress
- Receive reports
- Teach the program of the Woman's Convention
- Encourage conventional attendance
- Support the objectives of the Woman's Convention in each district.

ITS CONSTITUENCY:

Composed of circles and unions. This includes Circle Presidents, Special Workers, Young Adult Directors, and Youth Supervisor of each county represented in the District, and Union Presidents.

ITS LEADERSHIP:

Chairperson shall

- Cooperate with and relate to the Woman's Convention
- Preside over the conference and endeavor to enlist all missionaries and ministers to attend the conference each year.
- Cooperate with Special Workers, the Circle Presidents, the Young Adult Directors, and the Youth Supervisors in the Districts and Union Presidents.
- Endeavor to make the group a banner district group.
- Correspond with leaders in the group.
- Visit the County/City Unions when it is convenient in order to inspire workers.

Co-Chairperson shall

- perform the duties of the Chairperson and preside in his/her absence.

Secretary shall

- Keep a record of the proceedings of the conference
- Compile a roster of the Baptist churches in the District, the Pastors, County Unions, Presidents of the Unions, Presidents of Circles, Young Adult Directors, Associate Directors, Youth Supervisors, Associate Youth Supervisors, and Special Workers with their addresses.

Assistant Secretary shall

- Assist the Secretary in her work
- Serve as Chairperson of the Enlistment Committee of the Conference.

Other Officers as necessary

ITS COMMITTEES:

Worship Committee, Program Committee, and other committees deemed necessary.

ITS DEPARTMENTAL STATUS:

Should have three (3) departments: Senior, Young Adult and Youth.

ITS MEETING TIME(S):

Held annually by each District Group. District Group sets its own date.

ITS FINANCES:

Must report conventional reports and funds on the appropriate form within ten (10) days to the Woman's Convention. This is the responsibility of the Chairperson.
